



History of Monaco – Legacy and Heritage

A CHRONOLOGY OF KEY EVENTS IN THE HISTORY OF MONACO

- 1297: Francesco Grimaldi ("La Malizia") takes over Monaco, thus beginning the Grimaldi dynasty
- 1612: 1st Prince of Monaco (Prince Honoré II)
- 1866: Creation of Monte-Carlo
- 1910: Inauguration of the Oceanographic Museum by Prince Albert I
- 1929: 1st Grand Prix of Monaco
- 1956: Wedding of Prince Rainier III and Grace Kelly
- 1993: Monaco becomes the 183rd Member State of the United Nations
- 2000: Opening of Grimaldi Forum Monaco convention center
- 2005: Prince Albert II sworn in as head of state
- 2011: Wedding of Prince Albert II and Charlene Wittstock
- 2050: Commitment to carbon neutrality

Aside from the meeting spaces located in all the hotels in Monaco, there are a few distinct venues developed for the sole purpose of breaching the creative limits of meeting space

Grimaldi Forum



- An ideal location in the sunny Principality of Monaco, within walking distance of the largest hotels (1500 hotel rooms less than ten minutes away)
- Flexible & top-class infrastructures
- ISO 14001 certified and committed Convention Centre with eco-friendly solutions
- Tailored proposal for each event
- A full event management team in house to help you deliver high-end level events
- A total surface area of 35,000 m² for events from 300 to 3000 participants
 - 3 auditoria of 400, 800 and 1800 seats
 - 22 breakout meeting rooms from 20 up to 400 participants
 - 2 exhibition halls of 4000 m² each
 - 3 catering areas welcoming up to 500 participants each
- Since September 2019: The Grimaldi Forum became the first producer of green energy in the Principality with 2500 m² of solar panels on its roof
- September 2020: Opening of a new 600 m² terrace, an ideal outdoor area located next to the major exhibition hall
- By 2025: New offshore extension project in Monaco will allow the Grimaldi Forum to increase its exhibition capacity by 50% with and additional surface of nearly 6,000 m²


