



The Principality of Monaco enjoys a prime location in the heart of Europe, less than a two hour flight of the continent's major cities. Nice Côte d'Azur airport is just a short distance away, with numerous convenient transport links to Monaco.

The airport links the Principality of Monaco to more than **166 destinations**, with direct flights to **44 countries.**  There are now **58 airlines** operating daily services between Nice and the major European hubs. Nice is **France's second largest airport**, with over 12 million passengers every year.

#### **ON FOOT**

#### **BY BUS**

The bus company, Compagnie des Autobus de Monaco (C.A.M.), operates services throughout the Principality (timetables can be found in the Monaco Bus app). Routes cover all of the tourist attractions, business centres, and hotels. All buses in the Principality are hybrid (B30 biodiesel) or electric.

#### BY BUS BOAT

A solar-powered electric bus boat ferries passengers across Port Hercule, providing another pleasant way to get between Monaco's Old Town and the Monte-Carlo district. The service runs between 8 am and 8 pm every day, and is operated by Monaco Riviera Navigation.\*

#### BY ELECTRIC BICYCLE

MonaBike is an automated system of 350 electric bicycles available to use, at 49 docking stations dotted around the Principality. The service is operated by the Prince's Government of Monaco and Compagnie des Autobus de Monaco. The scheme is part of a policy aimed at reducing greenhouse gas emissions while improving shared mobility and quality of life in the Principality.

# A SUSTAINABLE DESTINATION

Since acceding to the throne in 2005, H.S.H. Prince Albert II of Monaco has been wedded to a strong policy aimed at promoting sustainable development on the national and international stage. Actions are focused on biodiversity, resources management, and greenhouse gas reductions.

To achieve these ambitious goals, the Mission for Energy Transition was created in 2016 on the wishes of H.S.H Prince Albert II.

The Destination and its partners are already adopting solutions to ensure that resources are managed in the most efficient way possible. Most hotels have opted for environmental certification, while soft mobility is being promoted through the development of a public transport network and efficient intermodal solutions. Awareness-raising actions are organised regularly to showcase our commitment not just to the environment, but to society too. The environment, social issues, sustainability, responsibility... These are not just words. In Monaco, they are a real priority for all. That's why, in 2022, the Monaco Government Tourist and Convention Authority, which is a signatory to the Glasgow Declaration (https://www.unwto.org/the-glasgow-declaration-on-climate-action-in-tourism), set up a dedicated unit specifically to address social and environmental responsibility issues, under the leadership of Estelle Antognelli.



The Principality has adopted a regulatory strategy aimed at phasing out single-use plastics gradually in preparation for a complete ban on their use by 2030. Commerce Engagé® and Restaurant Engagé® are official labels awarded by the Monaco Department of the Environment and the association Ecoscience Provence, designed to help local stakeholders and consumers adopt more sustainable



practices. Shops and restaurants with Commerce Engagé® and Restaurant Engagé® certification make efforts every day to reduce and sort waste, combat food waste, reduce their energy and water use, and promote awareness of sustainability issues with their customers.

The result of a project begun in 2020, the White Paper on Sustainable Tourism comes at a time when the tourism sector, affected by the health crisis, is becoming acutely aware of its responsibilities and the need to

rethink certain models.

The aim of this document, based on surveys, benchmarks, and dialogue with stakeholders, is to provide a better understanding of current tourism in Monaco, to identify its strengths and weaknesses in order to lay the foundations for tourism in the future, and to make it more sustainable by drawing inspiration from the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals and the Principality's own Energy Transition targets. The White Paper was prepared as part of a collegiate approach led by the Monaco Government Tourist and Convention Authority and the firm François Tourisme Consultants, along with all of the destination's partners, and support from the Mission for Energy Transition and the Department of the Environment.





## **« PELAGOS »** MARINE SANCTUARY

The Pelagos Sanctuary was established on 25 November 1999 by an agreement signed in Rome by the Principality of Monaco, Italy, and France. The agreement created a conservation area for marine mammals in the Mediterranean. The aim is to protect whales, dolphins, and seals and their habitats from all causes of disturbance, including pollution, noise, accidental capture, and injury. The sanctuary, located in an area known as the Corso-Liguro-Provençal Basin, is home to some 8,500 macroscopic animal species representing between 4 and 18% of the world's marine species. Whales Watching Monaco, developed in collaboration with the Prince Albert II Foundation, invites visitors to share one of the most exclusive experiences to be found anywhere on the Côte d'Azur. Accompanied by qualified professionals, and with complete respect for the environment, Whales Watching Monaco will take you to observe the majestic marine mammals of the PELAGOS sanctuary.

## PARKS & GARDENS IN MONACO

The Principality of Monaco is the second smallest independent state in the world. Parks and gardens occupy around 470,000 m<sup>2</sup> or 20% of the 2 km<sup>2</sup> country. The Princess Grace Rose Garden, the Jardins de la Petite-Afrique, the St. Martin Gardens, and the Japanese Garden are among the best known, but Monaco has many other public and private green spaces. It is important to protect this "green heritage", and a number of initiatives have been set up to ensure its conservation.

# **GRIMALDI FORUM**

A CONGRESS CENTER SUPORTING EVENTS

Conveniently located within just a few minutes' walking distance of the Principality's top hotels, the Grimaldi Forum Monaco is one of Europe's leading **eco-certified** congress centres. With **35,000 m**<sup>2</sup> of usable space, the centre is capable of hosting all kinds of professional events, from meetings and conferences to conventions and product launches for up to **3,000 guests**, in addition to trade shows and exhibitions.

Renowned in the international events industry for its world-class, multi-purpose facilities and highly professional staff, the Grimaldi Forum Monaco is without doubt the perfect setting to make your event truly unique. In April 2019, the venue embarked on a major project to install large solar panels. The Grimaldi Forum signed a "SunE" deal with the power company SMEG, which installed nearly 1,500 panels covering 2,500 m<sup>2</sup> of the congress centre's roof, generating up to 526 kW of power.

The project builds on the congress centre's strong green policy. In 2025, the Grimaldi Forum Monaco will celebrate its 25th anniversary.



## THE GRIMALDI FORUM: LOOKING FORWARD TO 2025



As part of the land reclamation project that will create a new district in the Principality of Monaco, the Grimaldi Forum is set to be extended, to create a new flexible, multipurpose infrastructure.

Already a world leader in the events industry, the Grimaldi Forum Monaco will be improved even further with the new urban development increasing its exhibition space by 50%, gaining an additional 6,000 m<sup>2</sup>. The new space will allow the centre to host even bigger events, host multiple events simultaneously, and provide greater flexibility, opening up the possibility of more original events.

It represents a unique opportunity and a genuine asset, adding to the destination's international appeal. The future Grimaldi Forum extension, a new flexible, multipurpose space, will have its own separate entrance and will also be connected directly to the rest of the building via the Diaghilev exhibition hall.

One Monte-Carlo, a brand-new conference centre, is the centrepiece of a completely redesigned district. ## THE ESPACE FONTVIEILLE (CHAPITEAU)

A large capacity event space within the Principality

Since 1986 the Espace Fontvieille Chapiteau has been a "fixed" structure, a testament to the longevity of the landmark event for which it was designed at the behest of Prince Rainier III of Monaco, namely the Festival International du Cirque de Monte-Carlo, the world's foremost celebration of the circus arts.

Located in the western district of Monaco on land reclaimed from the sea, the Espace Fontvieille and its 8,665 m<sup>2</sup> of space is the ideal venue for hosting all kinds of events, from gala dinners and private evenings to shows and exhibitions, new car unveilings and product launches, sports events, and much more.

## ESPACE LÉO FERRÉ

The Espace Léo Ferré is located at the Terrasses de Fontvieille, overlooking the port, at the foot of the Rock of Monaco.

Equipped with a modular stage, the multipurpose hall is available to hire and has all of the facilities needed to stage spectacular shows, or host dinners, exhibitions, trade fairs, or meetings.





In 2025, the Espace Léo Ferré will move from its current location above the Fontvieille shopping mall to a new site at the llot Pasteur complex.


