Hidden away in the Excelsior Gardens, the stylish bar will be opening for the high-season only, serving refined refreshments with unrivalled views of the Mediterranean. Le Méridien Beach Plaza teams up with the iconic crocodile brand to bring guests a special pop-up Café Lacoste. In a stylish yet laid-back atmosphere, visitors can indulge in a culinary experience with breathtaking views of the Mediterranean.

## Participating in the Festival des Etoilés, a series of exceptional dinners

The Festival des Etoilés Monte-Carlo returns, still celebrating culinary excellence with a series of exceptional dinners, gathering Michelin-starred chefs from around the world. The event kicks off on April 10 with a prestigious dinner at Grill\*, where Dominique Lory and Pierre Gagnaire reunite after 25 years. On June 20, Alain Ducasse and Albert Adrià will collaborate at Louis XV, blending French and Spanish cuisine. Yannick Alleno and Davide Oldani will host a convivial evening at Pavyllon on July 13, followed by an exceptional event at Blue Bay on July 18 with Marcel Ravin and Anne-Sophie Pic. A unique gala dinner will conclude this edition.



## Embark on a gastronomical journey across the continents

Some 139 different nationalities rub shoulders in Monaco all year round. The cosmopolitan atmosphere is reflected in the menus of the Principality's restaurants. From April to November, Peruvian culture is the order of the day at Coya Monte-Carlo mixed with delicate Asian gastronomic touches, just a short distance from Jimmy'z and La Salle des Etoiles. Japanese cuisine is married to perfection with other cultures for a culinary fusion experience that never fails to surprise and delight, like at Izakaya Cozza, where Japan meets Italy, or at Nobu Fairmont Monte-Carlo, serving a blend of Nipponese and South American influences in a cosy and welcoming atmosphere. And on the subject of winning combinations, Lebanon and the Mediterranean come together to stunning effect at Em Sherif, at the prestigious Hôtel de Paris Monte-Carlo. A subtle voyage of the senses in a cosy atmosphere with unrivalled sea views.

For further fusion, head to the <u>Blue Bay Marcel Ravin</u> at the Monte-Carlo Bay Hotel & Resort, where the two-time Michelin star chef unveils a cuisine that brings together Caribbean and Mediterranean delicacy. Not to be missed, Yatai, the new concept at the heart of Maya Bay, gives a fresh twist to ramen and shirashi with a Monaco touch.

## Nestle beneath the pine trees at the Méridien Beach Plaza

Beneath the pine trees overlooking the Mediterranean, the summer restaurant <u>Muse</u> sits alongside the Méridien Beach Plaza's private beach and pool. ## Eat with your toes in the water at the Larvotto seaside complex

The <u>Larvotto seaside complex</u>, is popular with locals and visitors thanks to its wide beach, shaded promenade, shops and restaurants. If you fancy a refreshing dip under the blue skies of the Riviera and the chance to grab a bit to eat with your toes in the cool water, there are plenty of concepts to choose from. Pick one of the four private beaches at the <u>Neptune</u>, <u>La Note Bleue</u>, <u>La Rose des Vents</u> or the <u>Miami</u>, each with its own unique atmosphere. There's also <u>Giacomo</u> with its Italian specialities, and <u>Sexy Tacos</u> for an authentic taste of Mexico in Monaco! And on the shaded promenade, <u>Bistro Coe</u> serves up refined dining from breakfast to dinner with a panoramic view of the Mediterranean.



## Take time out on a terrace by the water's edge

Relax on a terrace and share the moment with the ones you love. Now that's the recipe for a great holiday! The Principality is packed with places to kick back and luxuriate. There are so many little havens of peace and quiet, perfect for making the most of the tranquil local life, especially around its two marinas: Port Hercule, with its many different boats from superyachts to smaller cruisers, is home to the <u>Brasserie de Monaco</u>, <u>Old Wild West, Caffè Milano, Maison Gigi</u> and <u>Marius</u> as well as the <u>Quai des Artistes</u>, while the Port of Fontvieille is where you'll find traditional local boats moored alongside modern vessels, with <u>Tre Scalini</u>, <u>Amici Miei</u> ou encore le <u>Beefbar Monte-Carlo</u>!

#### Taste local delicacies at La Condamine Market.

How about starting your day the way the locals do it? Join the Monegasques at the <u>Condamine farmers' market</u> for a colourful morning while they think about what to cook later in the day. In addition to the chance to pick up some great produce, the market is the perfect place to meet up, have a spot of lunch, and taste some local delicacies like barbagiuàn or fougasse. Sitting at the foot of the Rock, in the shade of the Prince's Palace, Place de la Condamine is bustling with cafés and restaurants.

As the renowned Parisian contemporary art institution undergoes a five-year renovation, the Grimaldi Forum will host a curated selection of its finest collections. Called "Colors!", the 2025 summer exhibition will be an immersive journey through 20th-century art, offering a multisensory experience that combines vibrant colours, captivating sounds, and evocative scents. A second exhibition, titled "Monaco & the Napoleon(s)", will run from 12 July to 21 August 2025. This project will bring together collections from various institutions to explore the historical ties between the Napoleon and Grimaldi families.

## Enjoy great music at the Monte-Carlo Summer Festival

In Monaco, the stars are not only in restaurants or in the sky, but they can be found in the Sporting Monte-Carlo and at the Opéra Garnier. Every summer, they align in the Principality to offer entertainment and excitement with the unforgettable concerts of the Monte-Carlo Summer Festival Since 1974, some of the world's most famous names have been seen in the prestigious Salle des Etoiles: Frank Sinatra, Céline Dion, Cirque du Soleil, Tina Turner, and more recently John Legend, Jamie Cullum, and Rihanna... Kicking off the 2025 edition, the Fight Aids Monaco evening will pay tribute to Jean-Jacques Goldman on July 5 with the Goldmen. Throughout the summer, Monaco's nights will shine with performances by musical legends: from Billy Idol at the Red Cross Gala on July 12 to Benson Boone on July 16, and culminating in the iconic riffs of Carlos Santana on July 23. The festival will also groove to the electrifying beats of Paul Kalkbrenner on July 24, followed by a tribute to Dire Straits on July 25, before ending on a high note with Scorpions on July 26. From July 30 to August 10, the Principality will celebrate soulful classics with the Motown All-Stars' vibrant performances. On August 2, Will Smith takes the stage for a dynamic show blending rap and hip-hop. Wrapping up this spectacular festival, Kool & The Gang will bring their infectious energy to Monaco on August 13, before Giorgia closes the event with her captivating voice on August 15.

#### Looking ahead to 2050 with the new exhibition at the Oceanographic Museum

Following the success of the immersive exhibition "Polar Mission," which welcomed and engaged over 1.7 million visitors, the Oceanographic Museum opens a new chapter in its commitment to ocean protection with the immersive exhibition "Mediterranean 2050". This exhibition invites both young and old to travel through time, exploring an ideal future for the Mediterranean, rich in biodiversity, thanks to decisions made today. A true call to action, highlighting the need to protect this unique and fragile ecosystem, while inspiring both individual and collective commitment. The century-old establishment is also home to <u>The Prince and the Mediterranean</u>. Visitors board the Deo Juvante II and navigate, guided by the voice of H.S.H. Princess Stéphanie, through up-close and personal displays highlighting



the Prince's passion for the sea. Visitors are advised to end their visit with a stop at the Museum's terrace, a one-of-a-kind observation deck and intersection between sky, land and sea 85 metres above the Mediterranean.

## Celebrate the summer solstice on World Music Day

One of the longest days of the year is also a joyous celebration of music in many countries - and Monaco is no exception! Music is honoured in fitting style all over the Principality. From small open-air concerts in the middle of the city, to more intimate gatherings, to the traditional grand concert held at Port Hercule, there's a whole programme to delight music-lovers in every district of Monaco.

#### Celebrate the best of classical music in the Cour d'Honneur of the Prince's Palace

Every summer, the famous <u>Monte-Carlo Philharmonic Orchestra</u> relocates its prowess to the heart of the <u>Cour d'Honneur of the Prince's Palace</u>, where it stages performances unlike any other. The idea was first born in 1959 and revives an age-old Grimaldi family tradition. The orchestra gathers between the two flights of the seventeenth-century staircase, and the magic is instant. Classical music and the Prince's Palace come together, each enhancing the magnificence of the other...

#### Discover the best of contemporary art in the Principality

The Principality is home to a thriving art market. With international art galleries establishing bases in Monaco, the return of the auction houses, and its image as a cosmopolitan nation, the Principality is an important destination in many ways. It is the setting for two major annual contemporary art and design fairs, <u>art-montecarlo</u> in July and <u>Art3f</u> in August, both of which are open to all and honour the very best contemporary art.

#### Catch a movie under the stars

Throughout the summer, the <u>Open Air Cinema</u> screens movies outdoors to the delight of <u>cinephiles</u>. In a magnificent yet unusual location, at the end of a wooded garden just a short distance from the terraces of Monaco's prison, the open-air cinema is perfect for fun summer evenings with 500 seats, a giant screen of over 200 m<sup>2</sup>, an enchanting setting, and all films shown in their original versions!

## Watch live open-air performances at the Fort Antoine Theatre

A former fortress originally constructed in the early 18th century, this extraordinary site was destroyed in 1944 and rebuilt in 1953 at the initiative of Prince Rainier III, to the delight of locals and visitors of all ages! Every summer, the <u>Fort Antoine Theatre</u> overlooking Port Hercule hosts a series of dramatic and artistic performances. From the circus arts and singing to music, <u>open stage</u> and theatre, the events take place throughout the month of July in a magical setting, under the stars, facing the Mediterranean.



## Witness the changing of the guard and enjoy the prince's palace and its frescoes

This is one of the must-see attractions in the Principality at the Palace Square! Every day at 11:55 a.m., the Prince's Carabiniers perform the traditional <u>Changing of the Guard</u>: a privileged encounter with the centuries-old history of the Principality.

It's also an opportunity to discover the <u>State Apartments of the Prince's Palace</u>. Open from late March to October, visitors can enter the ceremonial rooms and bedrooms. A tour of the Princes' House which, in addition to offering a glimpse into the intimacy of the Princely Family, allows visitors to discover exceptional Italian Renaissance frescoes. These cover a total area of 600 m<sup>2</sup> and some of which remained hidden for nearly five centuries!

#### DAY 1

#### **Arrival in Monaco**

## Morning

Led by certified professionals, you'll have the chance to discover the large marine mammals of the Pelagos Sanctuary, a maritime area that is the subject of an agreement between Monaco, France and Italy to protect animals. ## Midday

#### Afternoon

In the afternoon, the Fontvieille district reveals its fragrant delights and thousands of blooms, as scintillating as their perfume, in the Princess Grace Rose Garden. Opened in 1984 by Prince Rainier III as a tribute to his wife, the Builder Prince personally selected the garden's 315 varieties at that time. Peace, calm and wonder are guaranteed!
